This used-book shop costs you NT\$100 to enter and reach through the 4000 books. The owner, Chan Ching-ping, designs the modern-looking interior with wooden tables and chairs, and a wall of shelves. 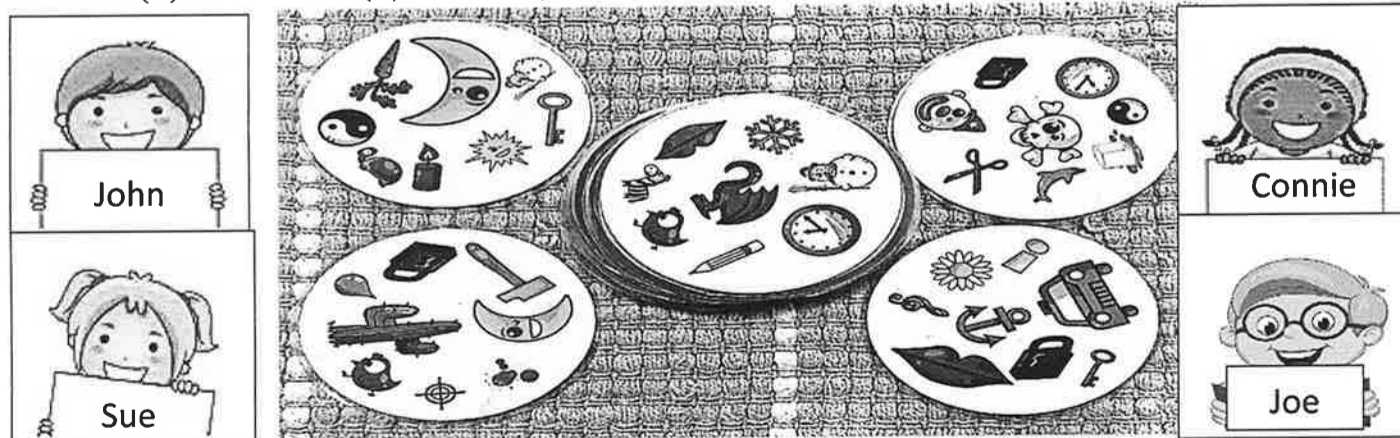
The winner:
